

ATI software transforms UTAX devices to convert print data from FTP to SFTP, ensuring secure transmission of print data.

Security request

A transport and haulage company based in Ireland wanted to be able to login to the FTP (File Transfer Protocol) using a password, making it SFTP (Secure File Transfer Protocol). This was needed for the secure transmission of delivery notes.

This wasn't something UTAX devices could do at the time, so they went to a different print manufacturer who initially said they could provide this level of security.

After the installation it transpired that their new devices couldn't support SFTP, so UTAX dealer Copymoore Document Solutions approached us again to see if we could look into supporting their customer further.
